KNOW YOUR CAMPUS

<u>ARYABHATTA</u>

Also known as the "Old Academic Block", Aryabhatta is the de-Facto heart of the college. It houses the main reception, library, classrooms, labs, administration office, the director's office, faculty offices, etc. You can meet faculty anytime to ask questions or seek clarifications or advice.

There is a library where you can go to study and/or borrow books. There's a sports room where you can go to issue sports equipment. This block also consists of labs and a PhD scholar's office. There is also a "Coffee Cove" where you can get coffee, tea, boost etc. during the college hours.



<u>RAMANUJAN</u>

Also known as the "New Academic Block", the Ramanujan block houses computer labs and classrooms on the ground floor, research labs (MINRO and SRL) on the first floor, along with seminar halls on each floor. It was inaugurated in 2017 and houses the Auditorium and Sports Complex on the 3rd and 2nd Floor respectively. At the front of the Ramanujan Block is "The Thinker's Statue" which is by far the most popular spot for IIIT-Bians to get a good photo for their social media accounts. It also has another "Coffee Cove" to make sure students AND faculty never run low on caffeine :)

HOSTELS

<u>BHASKARA</u>

Bhaskara, one of the two boys' hostels, houses around 70 triple sharing rooms on the first 2 floors and 400 single occupancy rooms on the remaining 5 floors. For the first two years students are expected to share their room with two other students. They are provided single rooms after the first two years. The rooms are well ventilated with two windows per room.

<u>LILAVATI</u>

Lilavati is the girls hostel of IIIT-B. It has two wings. Students get single rooms for all years of the course. However, they will have to shift their rooms every one or two years. There are two guards in the hostel, round the clock, and there is also housekeeping staff who clean the rooms on a daily basis. There are around 260 rooms spread over 5 floors. Calorie Bee, the girl's gym is present within the hostel.

VISVESVARAYA

This is the other boys' hostel. There are 4 Floors with around 90 rooms. Around 35 rooms are triple sharing with an attached bathroom and the others are single occupancy. The rooms are spacious with windows and each person gets their own cupboard and a desk.



MULTI PURPOSE HALL

The Multi-Purpose Hall or MPH is the recreational area for all the students at IIIT-B. It is on the ground floor of Bhaskara. It consists of a well-maintained badminton court, two table tennis tables, two foosball tables and also the men's gym: Shape Up. There are carrom and chess boards also in the MPH to enjoy in your free time.



The MPH also houses the state of the art SAC room, music room and dance room. You can always come here and jam with your buddies in the music room or maybe practice some dance moves in the dance room!

This year, the 8Bit corner (shown in the image above where your beloved team SquareOne is working hard For y'all :)) was also built in the MPH For students to come and sit together to study if they're tired of the student study halls or hangout while playing some games. Everyone is welcome here!

COLLEGE LIFE AND FACILITIES

FOOD MATTERS

There is a common mess and canteen For all students on the ground floor of Bhaskara. The mess provides four time meals i.e., breakfast, lunch, afternoon snacks and dinner. There is a non-veg (chicken) option available thrice a week for dinner. There is also a separate provision for Jain Food. The menu of the mess changes after every two weeks and all Food items at the canteen are present at affordable rates. The canteen timings are subject to change From time to time, but it usually closes at 2 AM and re-opens at 10 AM. There are 2 TVs installed in the mess for the students to stream sports while dining too.

<u>PARKING</u>

Parking Facilities on the campus are available For all students and Faculties at two locations: 1. The Front Gate 2. Bhaskara Basement

JUSTVEND

There is a vending Machine on Campus which is open all day and is restocked regularly. Here you can use the JustVend App to order what you want.



RECREATIONAL AREAS

There are couches on the first floor where you can hang out, meet up for group projects and team discussion etc. Also, there is an outdoor badminton court on the first floor of Bhaskara (well, you can always innovate new rules to fit the conventional sports there :)). Similarly there are common rooms in Lilavati too, along with a pantry! Other than hostels, the pond is also a great chill-put spot after heavy doses of academics!

LAUNDRY

There is a laundry room in the basement of Bhaskara which has washing machines and dryers. You can drop off your laundry basket there and the staff will do your laundry and you can collect it after 24 hrs. There are spaces available for drying clothes in the Hostels on each floor. If you want your clothes dried instanty using the dryer you need to pay Rs 100. There also is an ironing service at a per garment fixed price. You may avail these services on any day of the week. The washing machines are run using a card which will be given to you by the college management. You need to use this card while giving your laundry.



There are sufficient amounts of washrooms in both the hostel buildings which are cleaned everyday.



FIRE SAFETY AND EMERGENCY EXITS

All buildings are well equipped with various fire safety measures like alarms, smoke detectors and water sprinklers. There are emergency exits which are at a considerable distance from each room.

SPORTS FACILITIES

The Following sports facilities are in the college:

- 1. Basketball court
- 2. Volleyball/Tennis Court
- 3. Throwball Court (in Front of Lilavati)
- 4. 4 Indoor Badminton Courts
- 5. 3 Table Tennis Tables

There is a general-purpose field where sports like Football and cricket are played. Indoor games such as chess, carrom and table tennis are also played in the MPH. All the sports equipment can be issued from the sports room for a given period of time.



The timings of the gym are:

- 1. Monday Saturday: Morning 6:00 AM 9:00 AM, Evening 3:30 PM - 9:00 PM
- 2. On Sundays Gym remains closed



Both men and women have separate gyms and have treadmills and bicycles for cardiovascular workout & also have all the required equipment for weight lifting and strength gaining exercises.

The men's gym - ShapeUp, which was recently renovated to double its size and number of equipments, is located in the MPH and the women's gym -CalorieBee is located inside the women's hostel. Our fitness expert Mr. Girish Govind is availaible during the gym timings. He is responsible for making daywise workout plans and instructing your workout!

MEDICAL FACILITIES

The college has doctors available on campus for the following days and timings:

- 1. Dr Sachidanandam Muniswamy Tues, Fri and Sat 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm
- 2. Dr Bharathi P Mon, Wed & Thur 11:30 am to 2:00 pm

The consultation is Free but you will need to buy the medicines on your own. We also have an on campus para-medic For immediate first aid.

There is an Apollo Pharmacy store at walking distance From the campus. The Institute also has counseling psychologists who visit the campus every week. Every student gets a YourDost account, which provides Free online counseling services.

In case of medical emergencies kindly contact the security personnel at the Front desk in Aryabhatta, who will arrange for an ambulance at any time. This is a Free service provided by Kauvery hospital.



YourDOST

YourDOST is a platform which provides online as well as one-on-one in-person counseling through IIIT-B. It anonymously connects you with the right expert from their panel consisting of psychologists, psychotherapists, counselors, life coaches and career coaches, who understand you and guide you through completely confidential individual sessions. The counselors are also available for 2 days a week on campus and you can book an appointment in your free time for support.



Through IIIT-B you get free one-on-one couseling sessions where you can even choose an appropriate time according to your schedule. They ensure the following during a session:

- 1. <u>Complete confidentiality</u>
- 2. <u>Total privacy</u>

Counselling helps in maintaining good mental health by providing us with an outlet to seek advice for changes that can be implemented in our lifestyle to keep our minds healthy, even resulting in improved efficiency. You can make use of the services of YourDost via your college Email ID. You can also look up the services provided on their official website <u>yourdost.com</u>. So let us all try and break the stereotypes behind mental health counseling :)

HOSPITALS NEARBY:

We also in close proximity to Narayana-Hridaa Hospital and Kauvery Hospital. We have a tie-up with these hospitals For emergency ambulance service. Medical insurance upto two lakhs rupees per annum is also provide For hospital admissions which are longer than 24 hours. The premium For this is part of the Fees.





THINGS TO BRING

Your luggage, which will consist of clothes, footwear, toiletries and other personal items.;

- Sports shoes (First years have compulsory Physical Education classes)
- Scientific calculator
- Lock and key for the room
- Shoulder/Laptop bag and water bottle
- Any medicine that you may require (There is no pharmacy inside the college but an outlet of Apollo pharmacy is located very close to the campus)
- Extension cord (Not mandatory but recommended)
- The Following things will be available in the campus at competitive prices (can be brought from outside too): Mattress 3x6 Ft (Bigger size mattresses can be ordered) and bed sheets, pillows, bathroom supplies buckets, mugs, soap, clothes hangers, etc.
- There is a D-Mart outlet located approximately 1.5 kms away from campus For purchasing necessary daily-use utilities, snacks and clothes. For any stationery related equipment, there is a store named Kumkum enterprises at a walking distance from the campus.

IMPORTANT

Electric appliances such as iron, stove, induction plate etc. are not permitted in hostel rooms. Use of these will attract punitive actions and penalties from the Institute.

LAPTOP GUIDE

Welcome to college life, where the right laptop can make all the difference in your academic journey. Here's everything you need to know to make an informed decision:

- <u>PROCESSOR</u>: Choose between Intel i5, i7, AMD Ryzen 5 (R5), and Ryzen 7 (R7). While i5 or R5 will suffice for most college tasks, opting for i7 or R7will make computationally heavy tasks easier and faster, ideal for compiling software, editing videos, and working with large databases.
- <u>RAM</u>: Opt For at least 8GB of RAM For smooth multitasking, such as creating documents, basic gaming, and streaming movies. Consider upgrading to 16GB For tasks like streaming HD movies, basic photo and video editing, and gaming.
- <u>STORAGE</u>: Decide between HDD and SSD. HDD is suitable for storing large files like films and music, while SSD offers faster boot and loading times, ideal for graphic files, games, and heavy-duty programs. Consider using an SSD with an external HDD for maximum flexibility.
- <u>GRAPHICS</u>: Choose between Integrated Graphics for everyday use and Dedicated Graphics for tasks like gaming, video editing, and design work.
- <u>SCREEN SIZE</u>: Opt For 14–16 inches For portability and usability, suitable For professionals, students, and entry-level gamers.
 Consider 17–19 inches For high-end gaming, graphic design, and multimedia tasks.

 <u>ADDITIONAL FEATURES</u>: Pay attention to body material for durability and aesthetics. Ensure a battery life of over 6 hours, especially for long college days. Gaming laptops may have shorter battery life.

Armed with this knowledge, you're ready to find the perfect laptop companion for your college adventures. Happy shopping!

<u>Í MACBOOK</u>

IF you don't have any interest in gaming and have a budget >80k, an M1 equipped MacBook Air is the best choice For college work!

SOME OF THE BEST FEATURES OF MI MACS :

- MacOS has a UNIX based environment which is perfect for coding and development purposes hence you will not need to dual boot your device with a linux installation like linux users.
- It has an extremely good battery life. It lasts for a complete day (13–15 hrs, even more if you get the M2 or pro versions) on a single charge.
- As of now none of the students with the M1 and M2 macs have had any software compatibility issues.
- The M1 and M2 processors are currently Few of the industry leading processors. This translates to Faster app build times, seamless video editing experience and an overall smooth experience.
- It's integrated Graphics Card (= NVIDIA 1650 MaxQ in terms of raw performance) is also very capable for all the graphic heavy softwares.
- It's screen resolution and color accuracy gives a better experience in Fields oF graphic designing and content

creation. A sharper screen with 16:10 also permits displaying multiple lines of code on a single page.

- It has a 400/500(400 For the M1 and 500 For the M2) nits display panel which allows outdoor usage.
- It has an extremely smooth UI and is very addictive once you switch (disclaimer to your pockets lol).

SOME THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE BUYING A MAC:

- Do NOT buy the intel equipped mac (go For M1 or M2, even between these 2 options, M1 is more than sufficient for the work that will be done in the institute. M3 is obviously great too, but definitely not necessary considering your use case in college.)
- The MacBook Pro doesn't have a significant advantage over Air, So, instead of spending more for a Pro, you can use your budget in buying an Air with upgraded storage and RAM options.
- Buy it from the official website with the student discount offer.
- Storage is non expandable but the college provides 1 TB of cloud storage.
- RAM in base models of MacBook Air (both M1 and M2) is 8GB non expandable but it is more than enough.
- Lack of ports might act as an issue as only 2 type C ports in are available in the current generation of macs (late 2020) but you can always buy a multi-port adapter.
- There may be some softwares which have different functionality which may require some extra research and effort.

DISCIPLINE

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- There should be complete silence on corridors near classrooms during class hours to maintain an academic atmosphere. Students must not loiter in the corridors during class hours.
- 2. No student is allowed to leave the lecture hall without the faculty's permission or until the lecture is finished.
- 3. Students are not permitted to smoke or use tobacco, alcohol or any such substance on the institute campus. They are liable to severe disciplinary action (even dismissal) if Found violating the norms on the campus.
- 4. Strict disciplinary action (even dismissal) will be taken against any student found in possession of, or under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- 5. Ragging is Forbidden by the laws of the country. Students Found ragging will be handed over to the police. They may be dismissed from the institute.
- 6. Unbecoming language or conduct, obscenity in word or deed renders a student liable to disciplinary action which may involve suspension, fine or dismissal.
- 7. The campus must be kept clean at all times. Littering with wrappers, waste paper, defacing the walls or desks, damaging the institute property etc. are offences and are liable for punitive action.

DISCIPLINE

- 8. Though the institute is not responsible for the conduct of its students outside the premises, it *w*ill take note of any serious misconduct outside the campus.
- 9. Students must observe punctuality. At the discretion of the course instructor, the student may be permitted to enter the classroom if they are late. However, if the student is regularly late to the class, they may not be permitted to attend classes.
- 10. Every student is required to carry their identity card in the institute and display it whenever required. The card should be shown to any member of the staff or institute officials whenever asked for. These identity cards are also used for recording the movement (entry/exit) of the students.
 - 11. The institute expects every student to take active participation in non-academic Functions and cultural programs. However, such events shall be held only after class hours. Practice for all programs should be held outside of class hours.

VISTORS

Timings on regular days for visitors to the campus are between 10 AM and 7 PM. Nobody except the students are allowed to be in the hostel rooms at any time during their stay at IIIT-B. This ensures the privacy and safety of you and the students around you.

My experience as a first-year student at IIIT-Bangalore was genuinely chill. The professors are great at what they teach and very helpful as well. I found the curriculum well-structured, with hardly any courses feeling like a waste of time. If you play your cards right you can easily balance both academics and extra-curriculars while enjoying every moment.
