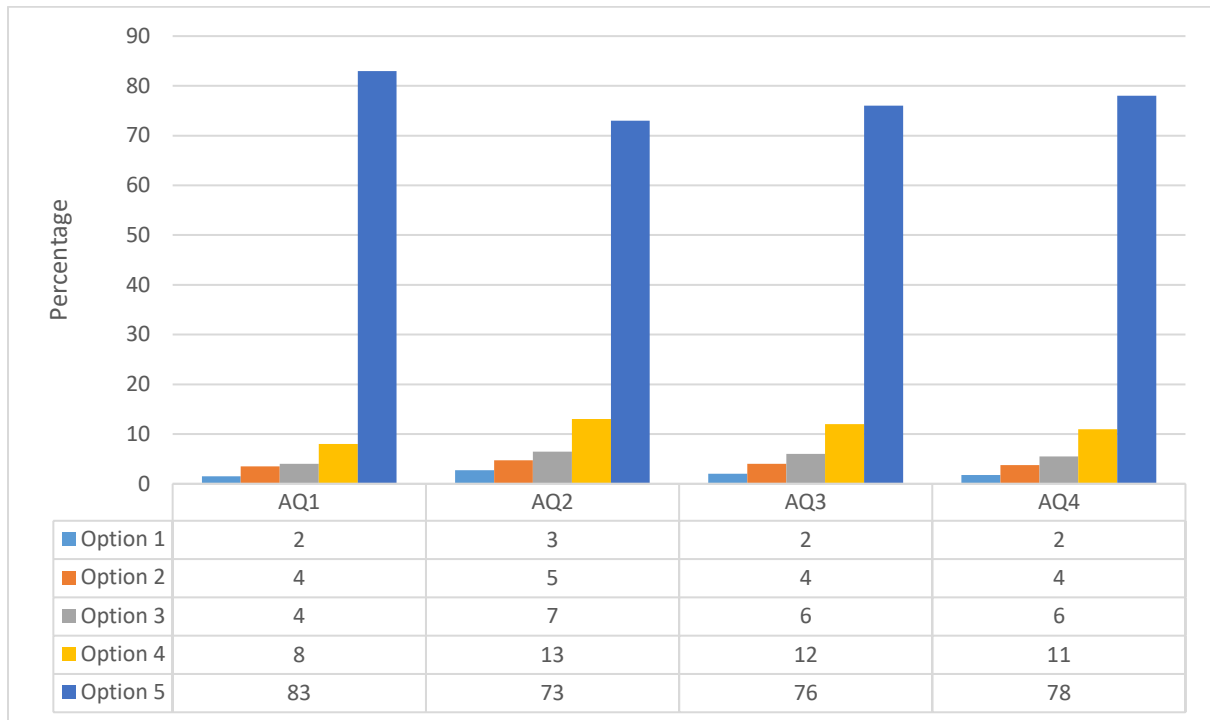
Introduction

 - survey administered to only new students who joined that year
2. Student life survey
 - for getting feedback on their experience while they are students
 - survey administered to all active students
3. Student Exit Survey
 - for capturing feedback at the time of graduation
 - survey administered to only graduating students

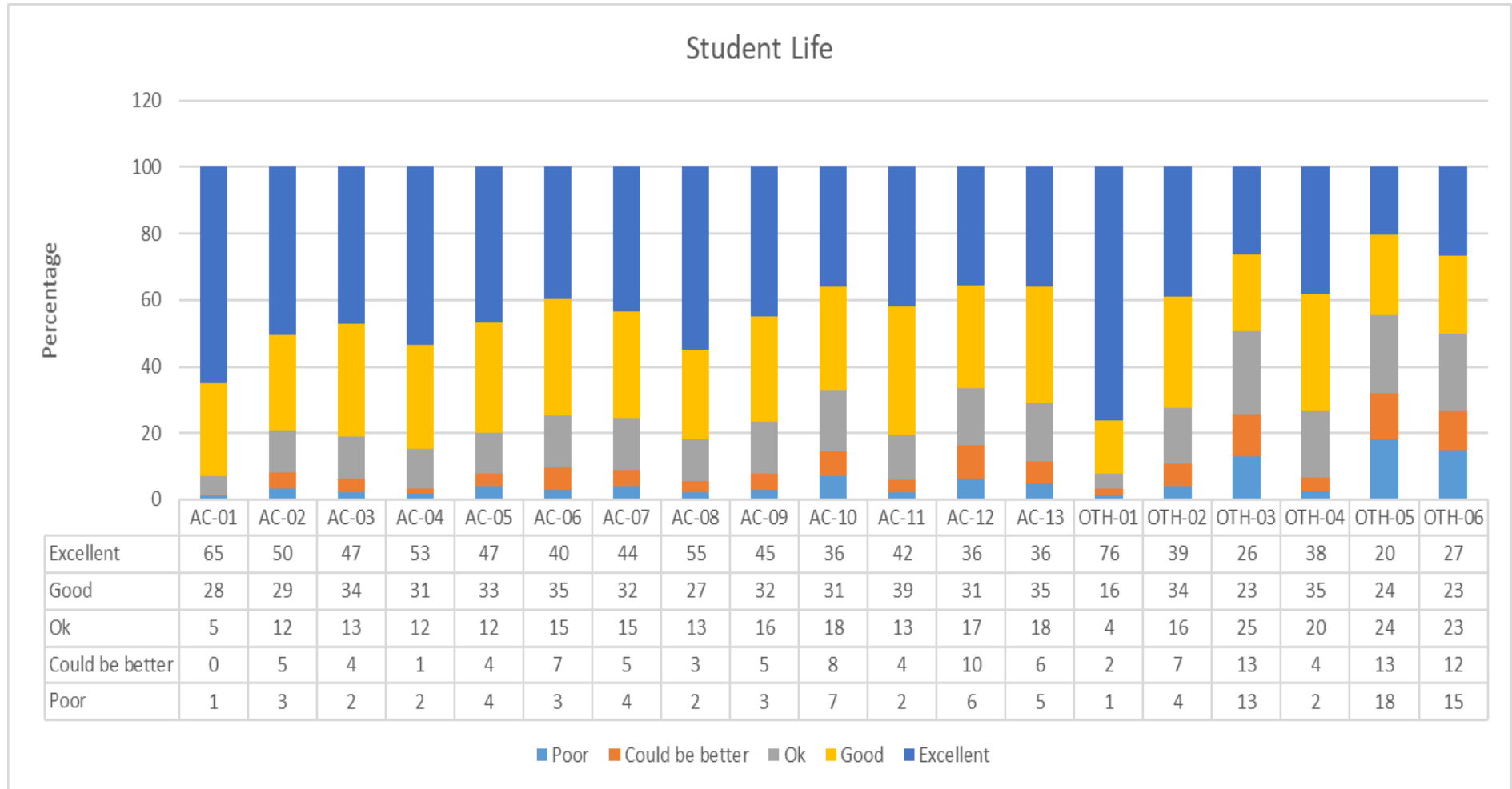

Analysis

- A majority of the students are EXCELLENT in all factors of student life
- On an average, 75% of the students have rated all questions as Excellent or Good
- More than 15% of the students have voiced a concern on timely discussion of test results with the students
- From the qualitative feedback, the following key observations can be noted:
 - Need for variety and improvement in taste is sought in food served in the institute
 - Suggestion to reduce attendance requirements to facilitate self-learning

- Need to increase number of recreational facilities is being felt
- Improvement in washroom cleanliness in Bhaskara needed
- More structured engagement of TAs in courses required

Other Feedback

S. No	Make mess dues optional or pay per meal basis
1.	Remove mandatory attendance. Some professors are horrendous teachers and attending their classes are a waste of time. A lot of people can do the same thing more efficiently on their own. On top of that, everyone's learning rate is different which even the best teachers can't address. Some students learn fast and classes mind-numbingly boring for them. Same goes for the opposite. It's ignorant and arrogant to assume that attending classes makes every student better.
2.	Better Food Variety, kindly remove the mix veg curry and any sort of 'curries'. Also it may sound a bit radical but switch from sweet deserts to fruits totally. It is done in JNCASR Bangalore. Maybe float a survey campus wide so gauge the opinion for this but it is a very important component that needs to be thought of. Also see if it is possible to reduce the charges for drying the laundry (Currently it is Rs 100 per bag). Also ask female cleaners to not come inside men hostels during early morning (I was bathing today and they were inside our communal bathroom to get their mopes, I felt ashamed). Timing of 10 AM to 6 PM is fine, not after that please.
3.	Washrooms are not clean
4.	Many electives time table is clashing this semester Students are facing difficulty in choosing the electives of their choice
5.	Water facility is poor. We need to walk the whole bhaskara to get water
6.	The marking scheme in some courses is biased, which needs to be worked on.
7.	Elective courses for vlsi specialization are very few. Course such as processor architecture should be there. ASIC course in first semester was very ordinary. Bathroom in bhaskara is not very clean. And lighting is low in bhaskara.
8.	1) Elective Courses for VLSI specialization are too low. There should be more courses. Like process architecture, some device courses should be there, ASIC course was not up to the mark. There should be at least 15 courses right now there are only 10 courses available. 2) Washrooms of Bhasakar are not very clean. 3) Light in bhaskara corridor is very dull. 4) Breakfast in mess is good. But lunch, snacks and dinner are not up to the mark. 5) Mess should provide more milk in evening. 1 small glass is too low.

9.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Only a couple of professors actually teach current topics and most of them seem to be more concerned about the evaluation rather than the point of the evaluation which is learning how to apply concepts. - Because of the sudden high influx of students, the number of options for project and reading electives have decreased (especially for those students who had to take courses before and are taking PEs and REs only in the third year). If there is some way to regulate this, it would be nice. - The quality of the food keeps falling. I have been a part of the institute for 4 years and it just keeps getting worse irrespective of any feedback given to the food committee. At this point, I wish that they change the company involved with this again. Based on the number of times we order food from outside, I wish there was a way we could at least save up on the mess fees (maybe a card based system?)
10.	Give clubs the budget they need. Clubs can do more marketing for the college in student circles than all the marketing done by the college itself. The lesser the friction between Admin and the Clubs, the lesser the friction between Admin and Students.

13.	I strongly believe that our courses should prioritize practical knowledge over theory. The lack of industry-oriented projects leaves many students without the essential experience needed for job placements. By incorporating project-based learning, we can empower students with real-world skills and the confidence to tackle professional challenges. Let's bridge the gap between academia and the industry to equip students for successful careers.
14.	After recruiting any faculty member, IIITB should have a faculty mentorship program where they are taught how to teach. Many faculties, even though being highly qualified lacks teaching skills. A teacher is a person who can explain whatever he knows clearly, not a person who knows everything and can't explain it to anyone else.
15.	some more equipment is required in the gym as the strength of students has increased.
16.	<p>It would be great if the professors and TAs could give us specific content that will help us with the course at the beginning of the semester. The TA I was assigned to for DSA did this, but not all of them, and in the other courses we did not even get that. It felt like we only figured out how to study the subject at the end of the semester. Each course has a different approach required for self study, in some cases the textbook is helpful and in some cases not so much. So it would be helpful for the TAs especially to share some insight on this having taken the course before.</p> <p>Although all our professors were very patient and knowledgeable, there is one small detail that I'd like to point out. Prof Muralidhara, despite his excellent teaching skills and explaining ability, had a habit of jumping from topic to topic and starting off random topics during the discussion. This often led to confusion about what was being taught for many of us. I would suggest that he introduces each subtopic or problem being discussed by writing a heading on the board and explaining its relevance to the overall topic being discussed before beginning the explanation.</p> <p>As for the hygiene of washrooms, I have often walked into the washrooms to find that some of the toilets have not been flushed or that there</p>

	<p>is no toilet paper left or that the toilet seat has dirty footprints on it. The hostel washrooms do not even have hand soap, which is considered a basic necessity. I suspect that the housekeeping staff, ironically those who are in charge of keeping the college and hostels clean, might need to be educated on using the washrooms in a hygienic manner.</p> <p>I hope that my suggestions will be taken into account to improve the lives of the students of this college. Thank you.</p>
17.	<p>1.Keep 2 water purifiers per floor in bhaskara. 2. Reduce course work so that students can focus on developing other skills and practice and learn DSA, and other corr subjects which will help in their placements. 3. Keep sessions with students in their 2nd,3rd year to inform them about the placement scenarios. What to study, where to study from (give some resources), give them some other suggestions which might help them in placements or in following their hobby.</p>

26.	<p>IITB research courses like MS/PHD, knowingly or unknowingly, gives the entire power of a research student's career to his/her supervisor. Students may not have the right to even question their guides approaches. And if they go and approach anyone, such as the MS/PHD coordinater, about their mental trauma, their career will be at stake as a supervisor has the power to make your life miserable or wonderful. I feel every research student must be allotted at least two guides, such that the student should be meeting the co-supervisor at least once in 2 months where they can discuss any issues related to research including, if necessary, issues related to the main supervisor. This will allow the main supervisor to correct his/her behaviour without going to the next level and their egos being affected.</p>

	<p>Also it should be mandated that research professors should come to college at least two times week and spend at least 8 hours in the campus. Currently many professors, just come to attend their classes and leave immediately, leaving the research discussion to happen over the phone or webex. If even the supervisor is lazy to come even to the campus, how would the students feel motivated to work in the problem? This is not how research is supposed to happen, you need the option to go and talk to your supervisor and interact with them face to face. Already, research in IIIT is a very lonely path unlike reputed research institutes of the world have a huge team where they can interact with many professors and team mates.</p> <p>MS students especially feel a huge burden as our course is more hectic than a 5 year PHD course. If possible, talk to MS students about their problems and give them the help they need.</p> <p>Overall, College should aim to better the lives of research students and NOT just focus on placements as IIITB is known as a research organisation, not a placement institute.</p>
27.	Food taste is same everyday. It's degrading each day. Please do something on food taste , hygiene and variety.

72.	Staff should be regularly updating the state of any faulty or broken facilities so that they may be fixed before even students plea.

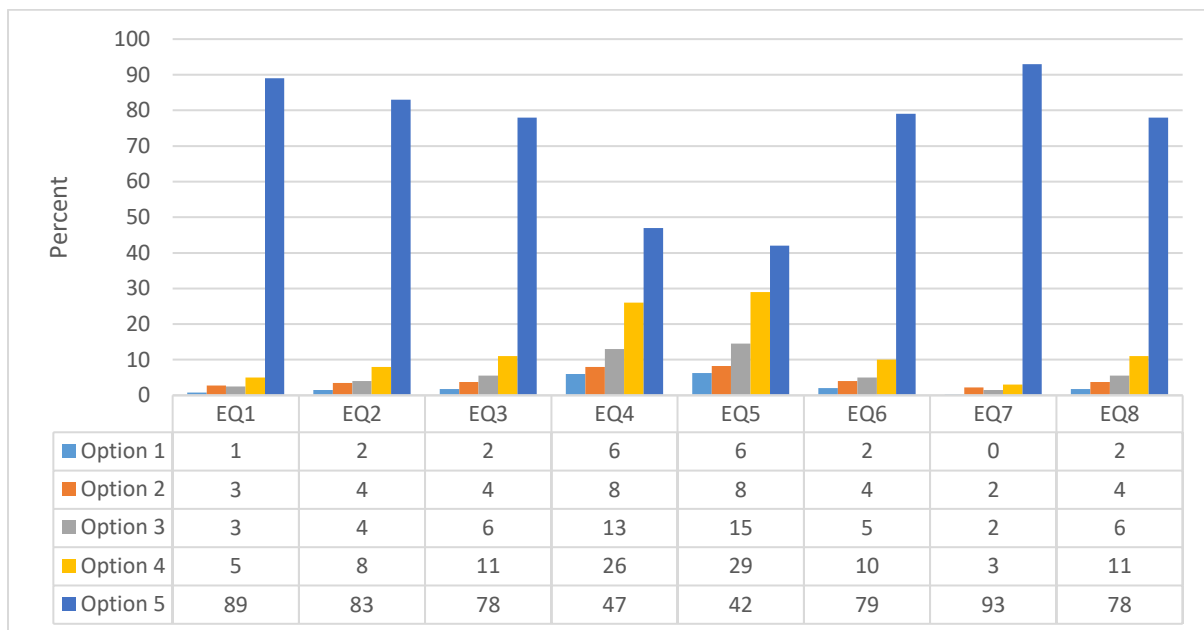

88.	Less resources and intake is increasing . College is on a downfall.
89.	The colleges reputation has recently declined due to obvious reasons as cutoff for iMtech is falling. The campus is getting more crowded and one cannot even have lunch in 30 mins as we have to wait in long lines. Bigger more comfortable classrooms are being assigned to only bigger junior batches. Ever since IMT2021 the cutoff for intake has more than doubled leading to drop in student quality as well as suffocation with

	overcrowded campus. Despite good teaching facility, the quality of student life has degraded in the past 2 years and the admin must disclose the reasons of increasing the intake when its clear that this small campus isnt sustainable for huge numbers.
90.	Up to semester 6, each semester should be 5 months long rather than 4 months. It has been noticed that courses are not finished within 4 months, and creates huge amount of crunch and stress for the students at the end of each semester. Maintaining the same amount of syllabus, while increasing the semester length to 5 months would lessen the immediate load faced by students at the end of semester.
